PROGRAM INFORMATION

As a gift to the Australian people, Arthur Boyd's vision for Bundanon was to provide an inspirational haven for artists of every discipline and at all stages in their careers.

The program supports artists' new work, research and collaborations. Australian and international artists are hosted in purpose-built studios located at the Bundanon properties on the Shoalhaven River in NSW for up to six weeks.

ELIGIBILITY

The Bundanon Trust Artist in Residence program is open to professional artists and groups, from Australia and overseas, working in all disciplines. Bundanon advances contemporary art practice through fostering artists, producers, directors, as well as curators and educators engaged in research and development.

Residencies under this program do not necessarily involve production based outcomes. However, potential to engage with the arts community/audiences regionally, nationally or internationally is desirable.

We encourage Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander artists to apply.

Organisations or individuals wishing to host workshops, symposia, master classes and conferences at Bundanon or Riversdale should contact the Trust.

VISITORS, INCLUDING PARTNERS AND CHILDREN OF RESIDENT ARTISTS, ARE NOT PERMITTED TO STAY ON THE TRUST PROPERTIES DUE TO LIMITED RESOURCES (SUCH AS WATER) AND THE NEED TO RESPECT THE SOLITUDE OF FELLOW ARTISTS. Artists with exceptional circumstances can apply to the CEO for special consideration – overnight charges apply.

BUNDANON IS A WILDLIFE SANCTUARY. PETS AND OTHER ANIMALS ARE NOT ALLOWED ONTO ANY OF THE TRUST'S PROPERTIES.

COSTS & SUBSIDIES

The Artist in Residence program at Bundanon benefits from the financial support of public funding and individual donors. However you will be required to make a financial contribution towards the cost of your stay.

If you are applying for grants or other support for a project you will be working on during your residency at Bundanon, you should include a request for the following costs in your budget.

Artist in Residence, Accommodation Costs 2012

RESIDENCY TYPE	Individual Artists Group of Artists (up to 10 people)
Bundanon Charge per person, per night	\$40
RESIDENCY TYPE	Group of Artists 11 + Organisations
Bundanon Charge per person, per night	\$65
RESIDENCY TYPE	Group of Artists 11+ or Organisations plus catering (breakfast, lunch, dinner) is only available for groups of 11+
Bundanon Charge per person, per night	\$115

If you will have difficulty meeting the accommodation costs, or your project will not be able to proceed without external funding, you can request consideration for subsidy from Bundanon on the AIR application form. This will have no bearing on the assessment of applications from individuals, but may be a consideration when assessing groups and companies.

You will be required to pay half the accommodation fee as a deposit when you return your signed Artist in Residence contract.

FACILITIES

Bundanon (Artist in Residence Complex)

The Bundanon Artist in Residence complex, designed by Sydney architects Tonkin Zulaikha, was opened by Arthur Boyd in 1998.

Operating 51 weeks a year, the site hosts over 300 artists in residence annually. It offers studio space and purpose built accommodation for up to ten individuals in single or shared accommodation in six residences.

The Dorothy Porter Rehearsal Studio for dance and performance is a flexible space (6.31m x 11.570m) with sprung floors and high ceilings, suitable for artists or groups who require a larger working area.

Riversdale (The Arthur and Yvonne Boyd Education Centre)

The celebrated Glenn Murcutt designed Arthur and Yvonne Boyd Education Centre at Riversdale can also be utilised for group residencies (11+ residents) at certain times of the year. It comprises 16 twin rooms to accommodate a maximum of 32 people in shared facilities. It is important to contact the Arts Program Officer (02) 4422 2108 before applying for a group residency to discuss availability.

Please ensure you submit all material requested including necessary documentation and support material.

- Complete all details on the application form applicable to you.
- Ensure you label your support material clearly. eg `firstname_surname_1`; `firstname_surname_2`
- Submit your Supporting Material Captions form, including matching numbers to captions.
- Artists supplying DVD footage as support material cannot exceed 8MG
- If you have trouble with the interactive PDF form supplied, please create your own using the template.

Application submission is via the Bundanon Trust website. (If your form is not submitting please check the form carefully for messages in red indicating you have not completed a field.)

Group and Individual applications are considered separately.
