

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The Setting

Two and a half hours from Sydney and Canberra, Bundanon is located within a unique bush and parkland setting overlooking the Shoalhaven River, on the South Coast of New South Wales.


Bundanon is a centre for arts and learning set within a 1,000-hectare wildlife sanctuary. Established in 1993, Bundanon was gifted to the Australian people by artists Arthur and Yvonne Boyd.

With accommodation for up to 96 guests*, Bundanon is the perfect setting for your destination wedding. Your guests will be able to stop, be present and fully enjoy the experience, without the need to travel. Flexible packages allow you to stay one or two nights and bring your own styling, catering, and your choice of vendors to create your vision.

Bundanon Weddings



Award-Winning Facilities

Bundanon's new Art Museum and the Bridge opened to the public in early 2022. The design recently saw Kerstin Thompson Architects awarded the prestigious Sulman Medal for Public Architecture.

Set into the landscape, the Art Museum presents a year-round program of exhibitions of modern, contemporary and First Nations art.

The Bridge incorporates exemplary sustainability features, encompassing Bundanon's net zero ambitions. Powered by solar panels, the design features passive temperature management, black water treatment, harvesting and storing of rainwater, local materials throughout and a reduced reliance on fossil fuel sources.

The Bridge offers new accommodation for up to 64 guests, with each room featuring an ensuite bathroom and landscape views.

The Reception Venue

The Boyd Education Centre is a masterpiece.

Designed by internationally renowned Australian architects Glenn Murcutt, Wendy Lewin and Reg Lark, the Centre has sweeping views of the river and accommodation for 32 guests. With a spectacular forecourt and open plan hall area, it is a wonderful space for relaxing and enjoying the property's tranquil abundance.

The Boyd Education Centre was also awarded the Sulman Award for Public Architecture in 1999.

The Ceremony

With the Shoalhaven River glistening behind you, Bundanon's natural amphitheatre offers a truly memorable outdoor ceremony location. You are welcome to bring a wedding arbor, seating and any other styling elements required.

Alternative ceremony locations

For smaller weddings and a wet weather option, the dining room in the Bridge can seat up to 72 people in theatre-style seating.


An outdoor ceremony at the Homestead site is also an option.

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The Reception

A perfect setting for your special event, the Boyd Education Centre Hall features a forecourt, open plan hall, semi-commercial kitchen, and accommodation for guests all within the same building.

Glass doors that completely retract offer sweeping views of sunset over the Shoalhaven River. Furniture, tablecloths, crockery, cutlery and glassware are included in your package.

Bundanon weddings are completely BYO. Organise your own caterer, alcohol and bar service for your reception.

Included accommodation

All packages include 16 rooms of accommodation within the Boyd Education Centre, for a maximum of 32 guests.

Rooms include two single beds and are designed to take in the magnificent river views. Bathrooms are shared and rooms come with full linen and towels. Each room has a partition wall which can be opened to create rooms of four beds.

Additional accommodation

The Bridge has 32 bedrooms, all with ensuites. Rooms can be made up with either a king-size bed or two single beds. Open breezeways with lounge furniture provide areas for your guests to relax and appreciate the unique landscape.

All packages include one room in the Bridge for the bridal couple.

Additional rooms can be booked for guests, with a minimum booking of 10 rooms.



More information

All information provided is subject to change and subject to availability at time of booking. Bundanon is a multipurpose venue and there may be changes to the property between your booking and your wedding day, including landscaping and conservation works on our heritage sites.

Check-In and Check-Out

Midweek: You can start bump in from 10am the first day and check into accommodation from 4pm. Check-out is 10am on the last day.

Weekends: You can check in from 3pm the first day and check-out is strictly 10am on the last day.

All additional furniture, equipment and styling elements must be removed by check-out.

Accommodation Costs

Many couples offset the cost of accommodation. On average, couples ask their guests to pay \$100 each towards accommodation per night.

Bundanon does not manage individual payments.

For Your Caterer


